



## BOLTING RABBIT INSTRUCTIONS

Designed to teach your dog steadiness control – it can be used to either simulate whilst your dog is hunting for live or shot game or whilst the dog is sitting.

Initially stand between the moving dummy and your dog so you can be at hand if your dog starts to move. Put your hand to stop your dog, blow the whistle and say, initially, 'NO'.

Have at hand your slip lead in this exercise so the dog can be pulled up immediately.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

1. Screw spiral tether stake (with the rubber attached) fully down into the ground in a smooth area.
2. Keep your body to one side, pull back the rubber elastic to approximately twice its length and screw the second spiral stake fully into the ground.
3. Unroll remote toggle release cord.
4. Pull rubber back and connect to release clip.
5. Stand to one side and pull toggle release cord.

When training lesson is finished, remove both stakes from the ground, wipe with a lightly oiled cloth, store in dry conditions.

### **SAFETY**

- All participants (including dogs) to stand well clear whilst operating.
- If your dog is on a training lesson, work him from behind or at the side, never in front.
